Join us for an educational program involving your Westie! The Quality Westie program was developed by a number of long-time, experienced Westie owners and breeders, and was approved by the WHWTCA Board of Directors in 2015. The primary purpose is to educate the Westie owner. This program is a **non-competitive** conformation evaluation, where the dogs are measured against the Westie Standard, **not against each other**. This evaluation will provide the owners an opportunity to develop a deeper understanding of the Westie Breed Standard, and how to evaluate Westies for type, soundness, structure and temperament. This knowledge can be utilized when evaluating breeding Westies, conformation and/or performance prospects and family companions.

This event is open to **any** Westie that is registered with the AKC or CKC.

Westies must be 18 months or older and can be spayed or neutered or intact.

Westies can be clipped or hand-stripped, no show grooming – just a clean dog.

Participant will receive a detailed, two-page scoring sheet signed by each evaluator.

There will be a grooming demonstration with Q & A period, as well as a discussion regarding Westie health concerns.

This inaugural Quality Westie program being held in the New England region is being offered at a special rate of \$40 per Westie. Make check payable to WHWTCA.
